The majority of refugees worldwide are not in Europe, with more than 80% living in developing countries. Still, many people believe we can't accomodate any more refugees, often stating we have "already taken enough". But loooking at the data, what do we find? According to the latest numbers from Greece, there are 118,000 refugees and migrants in the country, of which 76,000 are in the mainland and 42,000 live in camps on the islands. Creating a new and more humane migration policy that fixes the fractured system introduced after the crafting of the EU-Turkey deal is urgent, and it is time for the EU to design a common EU refugee policy. #WeHaveSpace
